Corrective Action Plan #1

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:39

For family day care providers, unused electrical outlets must have an outlet plug cover, have a tamper-resistant cover, or be made inaccessible to a child. For center and school-age programs, unused electrical outlets must have a self-closing outlet cover or tamper-resistant cover.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

Several electrical outlet self-closing covers are broken and the electrical outlets are exposed.

Corrective Action:

The broken outlet covers must be replaced with functional covers.

Supporting Evidence:

A picture of the replacement covers will be submitted to verify compliance.

How Maintained:

Outlet covers must remain in good repair.

Corrective Action Plan #2

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:25

All equipment, utensils, kitchenware, dining tables, and food contact surfaces of equipment must be washed, rinsed, and sanitized after each meal. Toys capable of being placed in a child's mouth must be cleaned and sanitized daily, using a solution approved by the department. All providers, program employees, and children shall wash their hands with soap, before preparing food or beverages, eating, handling food, or feeding a child, and after changing a diaper, using the toilet, helping a child use a toilet, or coming into contact with bodily fluid.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

The dining tables cannot be properly sanitized due to exposed particle board under the laminate table covering.

Corrective Action:

The table top can be replaced or the exposed particle board can be covered with a food service grade caulk.

Supporting Evidence:

A picture of the completed repair will be submitted to verify compliance.

How Maintained:

The dining tables must be kept in good repair.

Corrective Action Plan #3

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:38

The following must be inaccessible to a child: (1) Firearms; (2) Pellet guns, BB guns, and cap guns; (3) Matches and lighters; (4) Tobacco products; (5) Choking and strangulation hazards; (6) Items capable of being pulled or tipped onto a child; (7) A platform measuring more than thirty inches above ground level, unless surrounded by a railing that is at least thirty-six inches tall with no more than five inches between openings; and (8) Other hazardous condition as identified by the department. The department may direct a provider to remove or correct a hazardous condition or circumstance not covered in this chapter, if the department considers the conditions or circumstances to have the potential to cause injury or illness to the children in care.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

The platform on the east exit has a railing that is 35" tall.

Corrective Action:

Additional material must be added to the railing so that it is at least 36" tall.

Supporting Evidence:

A picture of the correction will be submitted to verify compliance.

Corrective Action Plan #4

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:35

Playgrounds for all child care settings must be safe, in good repair, and free of debris, trash, and weeds. Playground equipment must be installed according to the manufacturer's instructions and maintained in good repair. For a center program, a fence that measures at least four feet high is required around the center's outdoor play space. For a family day care or school-age program, a fence that measures at least forty-two inches high may be required to separate the outdoor play space, if the department determines a body of water, vehicular traffic, or other hazard poses a risk of injury or death to a child.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

A fence gate is missing and portions of the fence are in need of repair. There are construction materials and broken toys in the outdoor play area.

Corrective Action:

The fence gate must be replaced and the fence repaired as needed. Construction materials and broken toys within the outdoor play area must be removed.

Supporting Evidence:

A picture of the fence repairs and removal of items will be submitted to OLA to verify compliance.

How Maintained:

The outdoor play area and fence must be kept in good repair.
