- (1) The child's name and date of birth;
- (2) The parent or guardian's name and telephone number;
- (3) An emergency contact name and telephone number;
- (4) Parental permission for emergency medical treatment;
- (5) The names of individuals authorized to pick up the child;
- (6) Health information, including any allergies or special needs;
- (7) A current immunization record or, for a school-age program, the name of the child's school;
- (8) Parental permission for medication;
- (9) The child's attendance records;
- (10) The date of the child's enrollment; and
- (11) The date on which the child's enrollment ends.

The provider shall annually review and update each record required under this section, and make the child's record

available to the department, upon request.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

A child's record was missing parental emergency medical care permission and was not verifiable at the time of inspection.

Corrections to be Made:

The provider will ensure that all required information for children in care is maintained and verifiable during inspections.

Corrections Made:

The provider submitted the proper documentation for the child to OLA.
