Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:42

A provider shall maintain a record for each child that includes:

- (1) The child's name and date of birth;
- (2) The parent or guardian's name and telephone number;
- (3) An emergency contact name and telephone number;
- (4) Parental permission for emergency medical treatment;
- (5) The names of individuals authorized to pick up the child;
- (6) Health information, including any allergies or special needs;
- (7) A current immunization record or, for a school-age program, the name of the child's school;
- (8) Parental permission for medication;
- (9) The child's attendance records;
- (10) The date of the child's enrollment; and
- (11) The date on which the child's enrollment ends.

The provider shall annually review and update each record required under this section, and make the child's record available to the department, upon request.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

Not all children records included the required information outlined in ARSD 67:42:17:42.

Corrections to be Made:

All children records need to included the required information outlined in 67:42:17:42.

Corrections Made:

All children records were updated to include the required information outlined in ARSD 67:42:17:42.

Compliance Plan Action #2

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:15

A child care provider shall maintain a record for each employee that includes:

- (1) The employee's name and date of birth;

- (2) The dates on which the employee began and ended employment;
- (3) Documentation of orientation and ongoing annual training, if the employee provides direct care and supervision of children;
- (4) A statement that:
 - (4a) Defines child abuse and neglect;
 - (4b) Sets forth the employee's responsibility to report all incidents of child abuse or neglect in accordance with SDCL 26-8A-3 and 26-8A-8; and
 - (4c) Is signed by the employee; and
- (5) The results of the background check.

All records required by this section must be reviewed and updated at least annually by the provider, made available to the department for verification of the contents, and retained by the provider for six months after the employee leaves the program.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

The provider only had one hour of ongoing annual training documented from 2024.

Corrections to be Made:

Documentation of six hours of annual training for 2024 to be submitted to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.

Corrections Made:

The provider completed the annual training and understands the annual training requirements.

Compliance Plan Action #3

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:26

A nap mat, blanket, or other sleep surface, other than the floor, for children over one year of age must be available for each child during nap time. A sleep surface must be maintained in good repair. A provider shall follow the safe sleep practices contained in Caring for Our Children: National Health and Safety Performance Standards, 4th Edition, for infants under the age of one.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

A Pack N Play was worn and not kept in good repair.

Corrections to be Made:

A sleep surface must be maintained in good repair.

Corrections Made:

The provider replaced their Pack N Play and will be kept in good repair.

Administrative Rule:

A pet, while permitted in the presence of children receiving care, must be current with its vaccinations, and have clean

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

Two of the provider's pets were not current with vaccinations.

Corrections to be Made:

All pets must be current with vaccinations.

The provider obtained documentation of pet's current vaccination records.
