The items listed below are those that the provider was not in compliance with at the time of the inspection.

Compliance Plan Action #1

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:10

All providers shall be at least eighteen years of age and demonstrate and maintain the ability to provide care that attends to the child's physical growth and development and to the physical, emotional, cognitive, and social needs of the child, as determined by the department.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

The provider failed to meet the physical needs of a child in care by not intervening when the child climbed onto a table, resulting in the child's injury.

*This non-compliance led to a serious injury involving a child in care.

Corrections to be Made:

Appropriate action was taken with the provider involved, including that the provider will not be left alone with children in care for a period of 12 weeks.

Corrections Made:

- Program administration met with all providers, including the provider involved in the incident, to review the program's policies and provide mentoring to ensure policies are consistently followed.
- Sanford Children's CHILD Services provided one-on-one technical assistance to enhance the provider's ability to interact with and meet the needs of the children in care.

Compliance Plan Action #2

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:49

A parent must be allowed to observe their child or children at any time. A parent must be notified by the provider immediately regarding any serious injuries received while the child is under care of the provider.

A parent must be notified by the provider within twenty-four hours of any changes in circumstances. For purposes of

this section, the term, changes in circumstances, means a change in the provider's registration or license, the suspension or revocation of the provider's license, a change in the program location, closure of the program, and a change in ownership of the program.

If a court order restricts a parent from having contact with a child, and if the provider has been given a copy of the court order, the provider shall deny access to the parent.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

The provider failed to immediately notify a parent of a serious injury that occurred while the child was in the provider's care.

Corrections to be Made:

A parent must be notified by the provider immediately regarding any serious injuries received while the child is under care of the provider.

Corrections Made:

Program administration met with all providers, including the provider involved in the incident, to review program policies and ensure a clear understanding that parents or guardians must be immediately notified of any serious injuries.

Compliance Plan Action #3

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:06

A provider shall, within twenty-four hours, report to the department.

- (1) A change of address;
- (2) Any major change in the operation or ownership of the program;
- (3) A change in the household size or composition;
- (4) Damage to or a change in the condition of the facility or home;
- (5) An investigation of the provider or a program employee, by the Division of Child Protection Services or law enforcement, concerning any allegation of:
 - (a) Child abuse or neglect; or
 - (b) Any action that may prohibit the provider or employee from meeting background check eligibility requirements;
- (6) Any injury to a child that requires medical attention or dental care; and
- (7) The death of a child, if related to a serious injury that occurred on the premises of the child care program.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

The provider failed to report a child's injury requiring medical attention to the Office of Licensing and Accreditation (OLA) within the required 24-hour timeframe.

Corrections to be Made:

A provider shall, within twenty-four hours, report to the department any injury to a child that requires medical attention or dental care.

Corrections Made:

Program administration is aware of the requirement to report any incident or change in circumstances outlined in ARSD 67:42:17:06 to OLA within 24 hours.

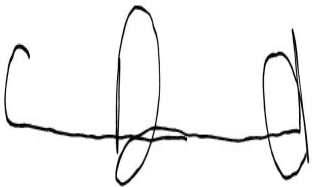
