Compliance Plan Action #1

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:25

All equipment, utensils, kitchenware, dining tables, and food contact surfaces of equipment must be washed, rinsed, and sanitized after each meal. Toys capable of being placed in a child's mouth must be cleaned and sanitized daily, using a solution approved by the department.

All providers, program employees, and children shall wash their hands with soap, before preparing food or beverages, eating, handling food, or feeding a child, and after changing a diaper, using the toilet, helping a child use a toilet, or coming into contact with bodily fluid.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

Providers and children did not wash their hands with soap after changing a diaper or helping a child use a toilet.

Corrections to be Made:

All providers, program employees, and children shall wash their hands with soap, before preparing food or beverages, eating, handling food, or feeding a child, and after changing a diaper, using the toilet, helping a child use a toilet, or coming into contact with bodily fluid.

Corrections Made:

Program administration reviewed the requirements of hand washing with classroom providers and will ensure sanitation requirements are followed.

Compliance Plan Action #2

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:44

All toxic or hazardous substances must be:

(1) Inaccessible to children;

- (2) Used according to manufacturer’s instructions;
- (3) Stored in the original or other labeled container; and
- (4) Disposed of according to manufacturer recommendations.

Bio-contaminants must be handled and disposed of properly.

Soiled diapers must be changed promptly, in a designated area, on a non-porous surface. The diaper changing area must be clean and disinfected with a sanitizing solution approved by the department. Soiled diapers must be kept in a leakproof, nonabsorbent container that is covered with a tight-fitting lid.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

Providers did not use a designated area for diaper changes and the diaper changing area was not disinfected with an approved sanitizer after changing a diaper.

Corrections to be Made:

The diaper changing area must be clean and disinfected with a sanitizing solution approved by the department.

Corrections Made:

Program administration reviewed the requirements of diaper changing with classroom providers. All providers will ensure soiled diapers are changed in a designated area and disinfected with a sanitizing solution.
