### Compliance Plan Action #1

**Administrative Rule:**

67:42:17:39

For family day care providers, unused electrical outlets must have an outlet plug cover, have a tamper-resistant cover, or be made inaccessible to a child.

For center and school-age programs, unused electrical outlets must have a self-closing outlet cover or tamper-resistant cover.

**Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:**

The program had some electrical outlets that did not have tamper resistant childproof covers.

**Corrections to be Made:**

Self-closing/tamper resistant electrical covers must be installed in all outlets.

**Corrections Made:**

The program installed tamper resistant electrical covers and sent pictures to the Office of Licensing and Accreditation.

### Compliance Plan Action #2

**Administrative Rule:**

67:42:17:35

Playgrounds for all child care settings must be safe, in good repair, and free of debris, trash, and weeds. Playground equipment must be installed according to the manufacturer's instructions and maintained in good repair.

For a center program, a fence that measures at least four feet high is required around the center's outdoor play space.

For a family day care or school-age program, a fence that measures at least forty-two inches high may be required to separate the outdoor play space, if the department determines a body of water, vehicular traffic, or other hazard poses a risk of injury or death to a child.

**Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:**

Playground equipment was being installed at the time of inspection.

**Corrections to be Made:**

Program must ensure playground equipment is installed properly and safe for children. Verification that it is complete must be sent in to the Office of Licensing and Accreditation.

**Corrections Made:**

The program submitted verification that the playground equipment is installed and safe for children.


