A sleep surface must be maintained in good repair.

A provider shall follow the safe sleep practices contained in **Caring for Our Children: National Health and Safety Performance Standards, 4th Edition**, for infants under the age of one.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

During inspection, a sound machine was observed to be inside an occupied crib with a child less than a year old.

Corrections to be Made:

The provider will ensure that the sleep area for children under one year of age is free of objects.

Corrections Made:

The provider immediately removed the object from the crib.

67:42:17:15

A child care provider shall maintain a record for each employee that includes:

- (1) The employee's name and date of birth;
- (2) The dates on which the employee began and ended employment;
- (3) Documentation of orientation and ongoing annual training, if the employee provides direct care and supervision of children;

(4) A statement that:

- (a) Defines child abuse and neglect;
- (b) Sets forth the employee's responsibility to report all incidents of child abuse or neglect in accordance with SDCL 26-8A-3 and 26-8A-8; and
- (c) Is signed by the employee; and

(5) The results of the background check.

All records required by this section must be reviewed and updated at least annually by the provider, made available to the department for verification of the contents, and retained by the provider for six months after the employee leaves the program.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

At the time of inspection, documentation of a staff member's CPR was not available.

Corrections to be Made:

The provider will ensure that documentation of the staff member's current CPR is obtained.

Corrections Made:

The provider submitted verification of compliance for the staff member.
