The items listed below are those that the provider was not in compliance with at the time of the inspection.

### Compliance Plan Action #1

**Administrative Rule:**

67:42:17:44

All toxic or hazardous substances must be:

- (1) Inaccessible to children;
- (2) Used according to manufacturer’s instructions;
- (3) Stored in the original or other labeled container; and
- (4) Disposed of according to manufacturer recommendations.

Bio-contaminants must be handled and disposed of properly.

Soiled diapers must be changed promptly, in a designated area, on a non-porous surface. The diaper changing area must be clean and disinfected with a sanitizing solution approved by the department. Soiled diapers must be kept in a leakproof, nonabsorbent container that is covered with a tight-fitting lid.

**Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:**

During the inspection, it was observed that the bleach sanitizing solution used for the diaper changing area did not meet the required bleach-to-water ratio for effective sanitization.

**Corrections to be Made:**

The provider will ensure all bleach solutions used for sanitizing the diaper changing area meet the required bleach-to-water ratio for effective sanitization.

**Corrections Made:**

Documentation verifying that the diaper changing area meets the required bleach-to-water ratio for effective sanitization was submitted.

### Compliance Plan Action #2

**Administrative Rule:**

67:42:17:25

All equipment, utensils, kitchenware, dining tables, and food contact surfaces of equipment must be washed, rinsed, and sanitized after each meal. Toys capable of being placed in a child's mouth must be cleaned and sanitized daily, using a solution approved by the department.

All providers, program employees, and children shall wash their hands with soap, before preparing food or beverages, eating, handling food, or feeding a child, and after changing a diaper, using the toilet, helping a child use a toilet, or coming into contact with bodily fluid.

**Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:**

During the inspection, it was observed that the bleach sanitizing solution used for sanitizing tabletops did not meet the required bleach-to-water ratio for effective sanitization.

**Corrections to be Made:**

The provider will ensure that the bleach solution used for sanitizing tabletops meets the required bleach-to-water ratio for effective sanitization.

**Corrections Made:**

Documentation showing the bleach solution used for sanitizing tabletops meets the required bleach-to-water ratio for effective sanitization was submitted.


