The following administrative rules have been found to be out of compliance. A corrective action plan is required to bring the provider into compliance. Continued non-compliance could lead to revocation of your license.

Corrective Action Plan #1

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:26

A nap mat, blanket, or other sleep surface, other than the floor, for children over one year of age must be available for each child during nap time.

A sleep surface must be maintained in good repair.

A provider shall follow the safe sleep practices contained in **Caring for Our Children: National Health and Safety Performance Standards, 4th Edition**, for infants under the age of one.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

During the annual inspection completed on September 30, 2025, a child under one year of age was observed in a pack-and-play containing a blanket, a pacifier clip, and a bottle. Additionally, two one-year-olds were observed sharing the same pack-and-play.

Corrective Action:

Provider will ensure all children under one year of age are placed in a safe sleep environment in accordance with safe sleep requirements as described in *Caring for Our Children: National Health and Safety Performance Standards, 4th Edition*.

All sleep areas will remain free of blankets, bottles, stuffed animals, toys, pillows, pacifier clips/strings, bibs, and other loose items. Infants will be placed to sleep on a firm, flat, non-inclined sleep surface.

Only one child will be placed in each pack-and-play at a time.

Provider will complete the *Safe Sleep Ambassador* training by **November 15, 2025**.

Provider will sign and date the Safe Sleep Acknowledgement statement confirming understanding of safe sleep requirements by **November 15, 2025**.

Supporting Evidence:

Completion certificate for the Safe Sleep Ambassador training will be submitted to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation by **November 15, 2025**.

Provider will submit the signed Safe Sleep Acknowledgement form to Child Care Licensing by **November 15, 2025**.

Child Care Licensing staff will conduct monitoring visits for 30 days to verify safe sleep compliance.

How Maintained:

Provider will visually check all sleep areas prior to placing a child to sleep to confirm no prohibited items are present.

Provider will consistently monitor sleep environments and maintain ongoing compliance with safe sleep requirements.

Provider understands future violations of safe sleep regulations may result in additional enforcement action.
