Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:26

A nap mat, blanket, or other sleep surface, other than the floor, for children over one year of age must be available for each child during nap time.

A sleep surface must be maintained in good repair.

A provider shall follow the safe sleep practices contained in **Caring for Our Children: National Health and Safety Performance Standards, 4th Edition**, for infants under the age of one.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

During a complaint investigation conducted by the Office of Licensing and Accreditation, the provider acknowledged an incident in which an infant under one year of age was permitted to sleep with a loose blanket.

Corrections to be Made:

The provider will take the Safe Sleep Ambassador training and will sign the acknowledgement statement verifying her understanding of the safe sleep requirements.

Corrections Made:

The acknowledgement statement was signed on 03//25/2026 during a monitoring visit. Safe Sleep Ambassador training certificate received on 04/10/2026.

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:31

An infant shall be fed according to the infant's schedule. The provider shall hold the infant's bottle when feeding the infant. The provider may not feed an infant by propping up the infant's bottle.

Food, including breast milk and formula, must be properly stored, kept at the proper temperature, and protected from potential contamination according to the preparing, feeding, and storing standards contained in **Caring for Our Children: National Health and Safety Performance Standards, 4th Edition**.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

During a complaint investigation conducted by the Office of Licensing and Accreditation, the provider acknowledged an incident in which an infant's bottle was propped with a blanket during feeding.

Corrections to be Made:

The provider will sign an acknowledgement statement verifying her understanding that infants may not be fed by propping the infant's bottle.

Corrections Made:

An acknowledgement statement was reviewed and signed by the provider during a monitoring visit on 03-25-2026.
