Compliance Plan Action #1

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:15

A child care provider shall maintain a record for each employee that includes:

- (1) The employee's name and date of birth;
- (2) The dates on which the employee began and ended employment;
- (3) Documentation of orientation and ongoing annual training, if the employee provides direct care and supervision of children;
- (4) A statement that:
 - (a) Defines child abuse and neglect;
 - (b) Sets forth the employee's responsibility to report all incidents of child abuse or neglect in accordance with SDCL 26-8A-3 and 26-8A-8; and
 - (c) Is signed by the employee; and
- (5) The results of the background check.

All records required by this section must be reviewed and updated at least annually by the provider, made available to the department for verification of the contents, and retained by the provider for six months after the employee leaves the program.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

Two providers did not have documentation verifying completion of the required 10 hours of annual training for 2025.

Corrections to be Made:

Two providers need to complete 10 hours of annual training to meet the 2025 training requirement.

Corrections Made:

Documentation verifying completion of 10 hours of annual training for the two staff members has been placed on file, and verification has been provided to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.

Compliance Plan Action #2

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:43

A provider shall have:

- (1) A written emergency preparedness and response plan for emergencies resulting from a natural disaster or a man-caused event;
- (2) A written plan for evacuation, relocation, shelter-in-place, or a lock-down, that includes accommodations for infants, toddlers, and children with disabilities or medical conditions;
- (3) A written procedure for communication and reunification with parents; and
- (4) A written procedure for the continuity of operations.

A provider shall practice the evacuation, shelter-in-place, and lock down procedures, outlined in the emergency preparedness and response plan, at least twice each calendar year. The provider shall document the dates on which the procedures are practiced. A provider shall communicate the emergency preparedness and response plan to each individual at the time the individual begins employment.

Except for family day care, all child care providers shall have liability insurance. Proof of current liability insurance shall be made available to the department, upon request.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

The program did not have documentation verifying the emergency preparedness drills completed in 2025.

Corrections to be Made:

The program will complete two evacuation drills, two shelter in place drills and two lockdown drills and submit verification to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:25

All equipment, utensils, kitchenware, dining tables, and food contact surfaces of equipment must be washed, rinsed, and sanitized after each meal. Toys capable of being placed in a child's mouth must be cleaned and sanitized daily, using a solution approved by the department.

All providers, program employees, and children shall wash their hands with soap, before preparing food or beverages, eating, handling food, or feeding a child, and after changing a diaper, using the toilet, helping a child use a toilet, or coming into contact with bodily fluid.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

The girls bathroom didn't have any soap for hand washing.
The boys bathroom had watered down soap for hand washing.

Corrections to be Made:

Provide soap for both the boys and girls bathroom for hand washing.

Corrections Made:

Hand soap was provided for both the boys and girls bathrooms for hand washing, including a large refill bottle.

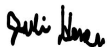
