Compliance Plan Action #1

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:44

All toxic or hazardous substances must be:

- (1) Inaccessible to children;
- (2) Used according to manufacturer's instructions;
- (3) Stored in the original or other labeled container; and
- (4) Disposed of according to manufacturer recommendations.

Bio-contaminants must be handled and disposed of properly.

Soiled diapers must be changed promptly, in a designated area, on a non-porous surface. The diaper changing area must be clean and disinfected with a sanitizing solution approved by the department. Soiled diapers must be kept in a leakproof, nonabsorbent container that is covered with a tight-fitting lid.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

Soiled diapers were placed in plastic bag hanging from cupboard handle in bathroom.

Corrections to be Made:

Provider will need to place soiled diapers in a leakproof, nonabsorbent container that is covered with a tight-fitting lid and submit verification to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.

Corrections Made:

Provider purchased a leakproof, nonabsorbent container that is covered with a tight-fitting lid to dispose of soiled diapers and submitted verification to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.

Compliance Plan Action #2

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:35

Playgrounds for all child care settings must be safe, in good repair, and free of debris, trash, and weeds. Playground equipment must be installed according to the manufacturer’s instructions and maintained in good repair.

For a center program, a fence that measures at least four feet high is required around the center’s outdoor play space.

For a family day care or school-age program, a fence that measures at least forty-two inches high may be required to separate the outdoor play space, if the department determines a body of water, vehicular traffic, or other hazard poses a risk of injury or death to a child.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

Playground equipment has worn post, peeling paint and loose bolts. Stand alone swing set shift side to side and has one open bracket at the top of the swing chain.

Corrections to be Made:

Provider will need to repair playground equipment and swing set to ensure it is safe and in good repair; then submit verification to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.

Corrections Made:

Provider repaired playground equipment and swing set then submitted verification to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.
