The items listed below are those that the provider was not in compliance with at the time of the inspection.

Compliance Plan Action #1

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:33

A provider shall meet the following requirements regarding bathrooms:

- (1) Bathroom facilities must be easily accessible by children and providers;
- (2) Hot water for faucets normally used by children in care may not exceed one hundred twenty degrees Fahrenheit;
- (3) Toilets and hand sinks must be kept clean and in good repair; and
- (4) For child care centers and school-age programs:
 - (a) All bathrooms must have natural or mechanical ventilation;
 - (b) Separate bathrooms must be available for males and females;
 - (c) Ratios for toilet and hand sinks must align with the minimum standards for plumbing and plumbing systems published by the plumbing commission.

Except in a family day care, hand sinks must be in the same room, or an unobstructed room adjacent to the diaper changing area. A handwashing sink used after diapering and toileting may not be used for food preparation.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

Hot water temperature was at one hundred thirty six degrees Fahrenheit.

Corrections to be Made:

Provider will turn the hot water temperature down to not exceed one hundred twenty degrees Fahrenheit and submitted verification to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.

Corrections Made:

Provider turned the hot water temperature down to not exceed one hundred twenty degrees Fahrenheit and submitted verification to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.

Compliance Plan Action #2

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:44

All toxic or hazardous substances must be:

- (1) Inaccessible to children;
- (2) Used according to manufacturer's instructions;
- (3) Stored in the original or other labeled container; and
- (4) Disposed of according to manufacturer recommendations.

Bio-contaminants must be handled and disposed of properly.

Soiled diapers must be changed promptly, in a designated area, on a non-porous surface. The diaper changing area must be clean and disinfected with a sanitizing solution approved by the department. Soiled diapers must be kept in a leakproof, nonabsorbent container that is covered with a tight-fitting lid.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

Diaper changing mat has tears.

Corrections to be Made:

Provider will replace the diaper changing mat and submit verification to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.

Corrections Made:

Provider replaced the diaper changing mat and submitted verification to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.

Compliance Plan Action #3

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:46

A provider shall complete pediatric first aid training every five years and maintain documentation of the training. A provider must be certified in pediatric cardiopulmonary resuscitation. The certification must include a hands-on skills test.

A provider shall work under supervision until the provider has completed the training required by this section. The supervisor shall have completed their pediatric first aid training and be certified in pediatric cardiopulmonary resuscitation.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

Provider's assistant has an expired pediatric cardiopulmonary resuscitation certification.

Corrections to be Made:

Provider's assistant will need to recertify in pediatric cardiopulmonary resuscitation and submit documentation to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.

Corrections Made:

Provider's assistant recertified in pediatric cardiopulmonary resuscitation and notified the Office of Licensing & Accreditation of completion.

Compliance Plan Action #4

Administrative Rule:

67:42:17:38

The following must be inaccessible to a child:

- (1) Firearms;
- (2) Pellet guns, BB guns, and cap guns;
- (3) Matches and lighters;
- (4) Tobacco products;
- (5) Choking and strangulation hazards;
- (6) Items capable of being pulled or tipped onto a child;
- (7) A platform measuring more than thirty inches above ground level, unless surrounded by a railing that is at least thirty-six inches tall with no more than five inches between openings; and
- (8) Other hazardous condition as identified by the department.

The department may direct a provider to remove or correct a hazardous condition or circumstance not covered in this chapter, if the department considers the conditions or circumstances to have the potential to cause injury or illness to the children in care.

Summary of Non-Compliance Finding:

Zipper on trampoline needs repair.

Corrections to be Made:

Provider will repair the zipper on trampoline and then submit verification to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.

Corrections Made:

Provider ordered a new safety net and in the meantime repaired the zipper on trampoline and submitted verification to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation.
