67:42:16:09 - Reporting incidents or changes in circumstances.

Summary of Compliance Issue:

Reporting incidents or changes in circumstances - The provider did not report to the department a change in the household composition.

The provider shall report a change in circumstance, such as a change in household size or composition, that may affect the provider's ability to comply with the registration requirements. The change must be reported to the department within 24 hours after the change in circumstance occurs.

The provider understands the reporting requirement and ensured the requirements for the household members were met. A Corrective Action Plan has been implemented with the Provider until October 31, 2023, and the Office of Licensing and Accreditation will continue to monitor the provider to ensure compliance with the child care licensing requirements.

Summary of Compliance Issue:

Background check - The provider did not obtain a background check for an individual residing in their home.

The department shall secure a background check to obtain information concerning convictions for criminal offenses or substantiated reports of child abuse or neglect by an individual that provides care or resides in a registered family day care home.

The background screening has been completed on the household member. A Corrective Action Plan has been implemented with the Provider until October 31, 2023, and the Office of Licensing and Accreditation will continue to monitor the provider to ensure compliance with the child care licensing requirements.

67:42:03:04.01 - Maximum number of children allowed.

Summary of Compliance Issue:

Maximum number of children allowed - The provider was found caring for fifteen children.

A family daycare provider may care for no more than twelve children including the provider's own children who are under six years of age.

At the time of the visit, the provider contacted a parent to pick up their children in order for the provider to meet compliance with the rule. The provider has a clear understanding of the requirements. A Corrective Action Plan has been implemented with the Provider until October 31, 2023, and the Office of Licensing and Accreditation will continue to monitor the provider to ensure compliance with the child care licensing requirements.

Summary of Compliance Issue:

Qualifications of a family day care provider - While the Provider was absent from the home, the Provider did not communicate to the provider's assistants information relating to the care of children or number of children present.

A family day care provider shall demonstrate the ability to provide care for children that attends to the child's physical growth and development and to the physical, emotional, cognitive, and social needs of the child.

The Provider submitted a plan to the Office of Licensing & Accreditation to ensure communication with the provider's assistants if the provider is absent from the family day care home. A Corrective Action Plan has been implemented with the Provider until October 31, 2023, and the Office of Licensing and Accreditation will continue to monitor the provider to ensure compliance with the child care licensing requirements.
